

How high should photovoltaic panels be installed in urban areas



Overview

Solar panels should be mounted at a height of 3. 25" from the roof's surface to ensure optimal performance. This measurement takes into account the seam of the SSMR, typically 1. 5" to 3" in height, the mounting hardware, adding approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ " and the module frame .
