

The role of the energy accumulator in the pump lubrication system



Overview

When the hydraulic pump forces fluid into the accumulator, the fluid compresses the nitrogen gas, reducing its volume and increasing its pressure, thereby storing energy. When system pressure drops, the compressed gas expands, pushing the stored fluid back into the hydraulic.

What Is an Accumulator and How Does It Work?

It acts as an energy reservoir, enabling the system to use a smaller pump by supplying a high volume of fluid for short bursts of peak demand. The stored gas also absorbs sudden pressure
